Healing: Is It Too Late For My Miracle?



“God’s Never Late, He’s Right On Time!”



“Jesus told her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying.’” – John 11:25

Read:

John 11:1-44

Ask/Discuss:

- Who was the friend of Jesus who died in this Bible Story?
- Who were Lazarus’ sisters?
- How long had Lazarus been dead when Jesus arrived?
- What did Jesus do when He saw the pain that Mary and Martha were in?
- What happened when Jesus spoke to Lazarus?

Say:

Jesus didn’t stop performing miracles when His earthly ministry ended. No way! He continues to perform miracles today. In fact, He wants to perform miracles both in and through each one of us. All we have to do is trust and believe.

Ask/Discuss:

- What are some miracles you’ve been waiting on for a long time?
- Have you ever felt like giving up on praying for a miracle?

Say:

Believing is the hardest part. Sometimes it seems that there is just no way a miracle can happen because we believe it is “just too late.” But it is never too late for Jesus! Even when it seems that all hope is lost, Jesus can show up and perform a miracle!

Pray:

Pray with your children if they are facing sickness or are in need of some kind of healing. Perhaps you can pray for a friend or family member who needs to be healed, too. Pray that God would heal their bodies, hearts, and minds like only He can do!
