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## A NOTE FROM PASTOR DAVE

Reading the Bible is a wonderful way to know God and understand His purposes. I am excited about your willingness to go after this challenge; I believe it will strengthen your walk with God and deepen your faith.

Although this may seem like a big undertaking, with small steps, consistently taken, you will be surprised at what you can accomplish. **By reading 3 to 4 chapters a day, you will get through the entire Bible in the course of a year.** As you read a chapter, just mark it off as you go. You get to determine where you read each day: maybe you want to read a Psalm and a chapter or two from the Old or New Testament, or maybe you want to tackle a book. Whatever you decide, interacting with God's word on a regular basis will transform your life!

Lastly, as you embark on this exciting journey, I want to encourage you to be an active reader. Underline verses or phrases that impact your heart; make notes in the margin (it's okay to mark up your Bible!) and memorize verses that resonate with His Spirit in you. Engage the passage not just as a spectator but as a participant. Remember, the Bible is God's Word for you and to you.
